## 17. Dundas Manor Land Sale

- Modest increase in price due to inflation
- What is the duty of board members? How to hold the fiduciary duty to the hospital?
- Complications arise when defining the hospital's interest.
- The dollars do not go into the operating budget. The dollars go into a "reserve fund" which holds money for special projects (i.e. buying land), and deficit funding.
- The money to purchase the land originated from the "reserve fund". These funds were an accumulation of years of operating surpluses.
- Peter Krajcovic declared his conflict of interest
- In the 2013-09-13 Board of Directors meeting minutes the purchase of land was discussed. The minutes state "There is merit in considering expanding our land holding for the potential build of another Community Care Building, or to possibly sell land to the Dundas Manor if it is required for the new build."
- The 2013-09-13 Board of Directors minutes final motion stated "Moved by Joyce Trask, seconded by Paul Caines that the WDMH Board of Directors authorize Administration to purchase 17 residential lots from Alan Racine for a maximum price of \$935,000. Carried.
