What are the major duties of a hairdresser at Dundas Manor?

The hairdresser will follow their own schedule in order to provide the necessary hair services to those resident's whom have consent provided either by the resident or their Power of Attorney. The hairdresser is managed under the direction of the home's Activity Program & Services Director.

Specific Duties include but are not limited to:

- Hair cut/trim
- Colour
- Perm
- Moustache/beard trim
- Eyebrow/ear trim
- Transferring residents to and from the salon for their appointment
- Performing infection control duties
- Utilize the 5 moments of hand hygiene as per policy and education
