### **Patient Instructions for Pulmonary Function Testing:**

1. Please arrive 15 min before your appointment time.
2. Please stop taking **all** respiratory inhalers, long-acting and short-acting, on day of testing.
3. If symptoms become difficult to manage, take your short-acting inhaler (ie. Ventolin/Salbutamol, Atrovent/Ipratropium Bromide) as needed and inform the Respiratory Therapist at time of testing.
4. You will need to follow specific instructions during the test. If there are any language barriers please bring an interpreter if available.
5. If you have new onset of cough, fever, chills or Covid-19 like symptoms, please call the clinic to reschedule your appointment at 613-774-2420 Ext. 6017. Reference the **publichealthontario.ca** website for updated signs and symptoms of Covid-19.
6. There is a waitlist for these tests. If you cannot attend your appointment, please notify the clinic (see number above), as soon as possible, so we can fill your appointment time with another patient.
7. Please bring:
  - a. A list of medications you are currently taking.
  - b. A valid health card (OHIP).
  - c. All prescribed inhalers
