## **What are the major duties of a Resident Aid at Dundas Manor?**

Some of the duties include but not limited to:

- Assisting residents to meal service B, L, S
- Providing nourishment cart to residents – morning, afternoon & evening
- Assisting with portering to activities
- Meal assistance to assigned residents & meal service help in general
- Putting out resident clothing & linen to clean utility rooms
- Spotting for 2 person lifts
- No formal documentation is required but communication to the most responsible PSW is expected
- Notification of resident change in status to RPN or RHA
