WDMH Foundation Bylaws – Approved June 14, 2023

ARTICLE 16 - MEMBERSHIP

- 16.1** Membership in the Corporation shall consist of:
- a) any person whose application for admission as a Member has been approved by a resolution of the Board; and
 - b) directors, upon their election as directors
- 16.2** Members must be of the full age of eighteen (18) years at the time their application is submitted.
- 16.3** Any annual membership in the Corporation shall be effective only from April 1 in one year to March 31 in the following year.
- 16.4** A Member shall not be entitled to vote at any meetings of the Corporation unless his/her application was received at least thirty (30) days prior to the date of the meeting and approval of the application for membership has been given by resolution of the Board in accordance with subsection 16.1
- 16.5** Membership is not transferable.
- 16.6** Upon 30 days' notice to a Member, the Board may pass a resolution authorizing the removal of any such Member and thereafter such person shall cease to be a Member.
- 16.7** A Member may resign from the Corporation by delivering a written resignation to the Secretary.
