I'm Cheryl Gibson, and I have been a Registered Nurse in the Perioperative Unit at the Winchester District Memorial Hospital (WDMH) for more than 30 years. Since joining the Operating Room (OR) team in 1994, I've developed a deep passion for the field; drawn to the teamwork, the technical specifications, and the advanced equipment that helps us provide top-quality patient care at WDMH. But I've also seen the challenges when essential tools – like our surgical operating table – are not available.

But instead of the reassuring call to confirm your surgery, you're told that due to a non-functional surgical operating table, your surgery must be delayed. At WDMH, the surgical operating table is the unsung hero behind every surgery. It supports patients, doctors, and medical teams through life-saving and routine surgeries.

But right now, one of our surgical operating tables is at its end of life. And that could mean delayed surgeries, added stress for patients and families, and increased wait times.

<u>Did you know that the provincial government does not provide funding to purchase medical equipment like operating tables?</u>

This table plays a critical role in surgeries, from emergency c-sections and urology surgery to general surgeries and gynecological care. It supports patients through both life-saving and routine surgeries, making it an essential part of surgical care at WDMH.

WDMH performs about 4,000 surgeries each year. That's a lot of patients on the operating table! But with three operating rooms and only two functioning operating tables, the ability to provide timely, efficient care is currently limited. A new surgical operating table will allow WDMH to perform critical surgeries without interruption.

This new table is also designed to adjust to various positions and heights based on the type of surgery, making it suitable for all surgical specialties. The cost of a new operating table is approximately \$59,000.
