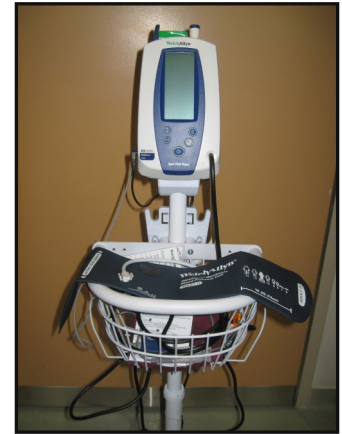

Vital Equipment

Through donations from generous donors, several new pieces of equipment have been purchased for WDMH's Continuing Care Unit. We are pleased to tell you about two new blood pressure monitors.

"The vital sign machines are up and running," notes Sean Burnett, Team Leader. "One is mounted in Room 419 which is a real time saver. We use this room mainly to isolate patients so having the machine in the room means it doesn't have to be cleaned each time as it isn't being shared." The other machine is mounted on a new, easy to push portable cart.
